FIRST AID: In case of emergency, call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

FOR USE AS A ONE-STEP, GENERAL, HOSPITAL DISINFECTANT, VIRUCIDE*, DEODORIZER, CLEANER:

1. Pre-clean visibly soiled areas. 2. To disinfect hard, non-porous, non-food contact surfaces, apply a use solution of 6 fl. oz. of this product per gal. of water (or equivalent use dilution) with a sponge, brush, cloth, mop, by immersion, auto scrubber, mechanical spray device, hand pump trigger spray device, coarse trigger spray device. For spray applications, spray 6-8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray. 3. Treated surfaces must remain visibly wet for 10 minutes. 4. Wipe dry with a clean cloth. 5. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when visibly dirty.

NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACE SANITIZING: Pre-clean visibly soiled surfaces. Add 6 fl. oz. of this product per gal. of water. Apply solution to hard, non-porous surfaces with a sponge, brush, cloth, mop, by immersion, hand pump trigger spray device, coarse trigger spray device. For spray applications, spray 6 - 8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray. Treated surfaces must remain visibly wet for 3 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when visibly dirty.

TO KILL FUNGI: Pre-clean visibly soiled surfaces. Prepare use solution by adding 6 fl. oz. of this product per gal. of water. Apply use solution to hard, non-porous, non-food contact surfaces. Allow surface to remain visibly wet for 10 minutes. Wipe surfaces.

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TO CONTROL MOLD/MILDEW: Pre-clean visibly soiled surfaces. Prepare use solution by adding 6 fl. oz. of this product per gal. of water. Apply use solution to hard, non-porous surfaces and allow to air dry, which will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and their odors. Repeat treatment every 7 days, or more often if new growth appears.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store only in original container. Keep this product under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Non-Refillable Container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Follow Pesticide Disposal instructions for rinsate disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe spray mist.
